BOYLES: I have just come to the end of it, including some critics that were leveled against the morning show here on 630 KHOW. Good morning it is November the 9th... The Fort Hood massacre....

Some guy writes a piece that gets sent to me by email: "Talk Radio Boyles Political Correctness to blame for Fort Hood Killing." Some guy named Joseph Boven writes this. We can invite Mr. Joseph Boven Boven on the radio show. Mr. Boven not only misquotes me but that's okay. I am all right with that. But let's just put it on the line.

BOYLES: I am reading this piece. Friday afternoon talk show host Peter Boyles -- I do mornings, Mr. Boven. I do mornings. Somebody sent me this. KHOW Friday afternoon Peter Boyles referring to a shooting spree of 12 soldiers and one civilian proclaimed that Islam is at war with America. Actually, Mr. Boven, what I said was "America says Islam is not -- that we are not at war with Islam but," I said, "Is Islam at war with the United States?" And I don't do afternoons. "Boyles also said that the suspect in the United States army had benefited from political correctness in his military career." I never said anything such thing as that. "And should have been subject to suspicion --" he was a Palestinian. I did say that. I don't know where these guys get this. But they seem to want to put it down. They found some guy, Abdul "legal adviser to the [Arab-American Anti-Discrimination Committee] told The Colorado Independent that since the news of the Fort Hood shootings his organization has been in crisis mode responding to tirades like Boyles as well as hate speech and threats."

We are going to have Robert Spencer on this radio show this morning. There has never been one retaliation in this country. It is like it is myth. Aunt Janet Napolitano, homeland security secretary, said she is working to prevent a possible wave of anti-Muslim sentiment. You know what, there has not been one case, one documented case of retaliation against a Muslim person or an Arab person in the United States of America.

BOYLES: Headline "Talk radio's Boyles said political correctness promotes killings." How do you like it? I am sick and tired of it, man. This PC crap. Do you believe that attack on Fort Hood was an act of terrorism? This is Joey. Good morning.

CALLER: Yes it was.

BOYLES: Somebody sends me thing... Headline: "Talk Radio Peter Boyles claims political correctness is to blame for Fort Hood..." and it is a big take down on me, including this legal adviser American Arab Anti-Discrimination Committee that they have been in crisis mode. Robert Spencer will come on the show. You know that there is not one case of retaliation not one case. It is like apples and it is like razor blades and apples. It is a myth. And how these numerous Muslim societies come out and say we must do this, we must do that. And I am telling you that there is no instance of retaliation.

Political correctness is one of the many tools being used against us here in this country to take us down. And I said and they quote me as saying, and I absolutely did say this. That I am telling you today, political correctness has gone too far. We allow a guy who has open sympathies for the very topic we are at war with to be promoted, given access to the troops, access to the weapons. Can you imagine a Nazi sympathizer accepted into the United States Army in the second world war? Yes, I absolutely said that.

CALLER: You make some great points, Pete, and I think that you are going to be hearing from a lot of people.

BOYLES: Let's see if we can hear from the people who want to be critical. Those are the people we really want to hear from.

BOYLES: The Muslim in speaking with this guy talk radio's Boyles political correctness to blame for Hood Killings they have gone to find these guys who said it is like hate speech. Let me read me read exactly what they say.

"Abed Ayoub, legal adviser to the American Arab Anti-Discrimination Committee, told The Colorado Independent ... since the news of the Fort Hood shootings" his organization has been "in crisis mode monitoring and responding to tirades like Boyles as well as hate speech and threats."

Like what threats? Like what threat? Name the threat? This is the same threat that Bill Ritter was getting at. Bill Ritter has a bad case of truthache. Was it terrorist attacks?

BOYLES: The thing that I said was George Bush and Barack Obama say we are not at war with Islam, and I said but, you know what, Islam is at war with you.

CALLER: That is a fact. And what do you do when you go to war?

BOYLES: I will just read it to you "Colorado Afternoon host Peter Boyles referring to the shooting spree murder of 12 soldiers.. at Fort Hood proclaimed that Islam is at war with America."

That is not what I said. I said that — they missed my criticisms of George Bush and Barack Obama — but, um, I mean, the fact that this guy [Hasan] writes that he is a Palestinian. They claimed that I said he was writing he was of Palestinian descent. No, the second paragraph. Boyles also said the suspect of the U.S. army had benefited from political correctness in his military carrier and should have been subject of suspicion for writing he was of Palestinian descent in his mosque.

No he didn't. The mosque asked him his nationality and he said Palestinian. CALLER: Let's keep protecting the Muslims while they destroy our people. That is a great idea. Fantastic. There is no doubt that the attack on Fort Hood was definitely an act of terrorism. When terrorists are about to do what they are about to do they always yell "Allah Akbar." That's--

BOYLES: Yeah, sure.

CALLER: And that is what this guy was doing.

BOYLES: Ask him if somebody with this man's political and religious beliefs would say that. He walked into the Army recruiter and instead of saying "Allah Akbar" said "Heil Hitler." Do you think that the military would have said "Come on in"?

CALLER: Hell no they wouldn't have.

BOYLES: Or "Hirohito is god" or--

CALLER: Our military and our leaders were not stupid.

BOYLES: It is not the GIs. It is not the GIs. That is the point that I am trying to make. These are guys and they make Colonel, like Colonel they want to get a star they don't want to buck, they don't want to have to face up to someone who says "You were racist when you would not promote or would pass over or thought that this guy was a bad guy."

<blockquote>BOYLES: Muslim in 21st century America. "Not all Muslims are terrorists but all terrorists are Muslim says radio talk show host Peter Boyles last week" this is another blog.

First of all, Islam's basic tenet means, "Submission." Imams say that Islam remains a religion of peace, but they fail to tell listeners that peace will arrive only when Islam becomes the sole religion in the world. Its prime directive in the Koran reads, "... convert or kill all non-believers, starting with the Jews."
